Graham Manley

Graham is a specialist in Paediatric Dentistry, Dental Public Health and Special Care Dentistry. His current posts are as Consultant in Special Care Dentistry, Eastern and Coastal Kent Primary Care Trust and as Head of Department/Consultant in Special Care Dentistry at the Royal Hospital for Neuro-disability, Putney London.

Nick Ransford

Nick qualified from Birmingham in 1983 and worked in Community Dental Services in Shropshire and Warwickshire becoming Clinical Director. He returned to Birmingham in 2009 as Consultant with lead responsibility for medically compromised patients and sedation. He has had over 20 years experience working with adults with disabilities and medical conditions across the spectrum. He is an examiner for postgraduate specialist qualifications in SCD at RCS England and the Eastman Dental Hospital.

Angel Alcaide Raya

Angel's first contact with sedation was in Madrid with oral benzodiazepines. He gained wide experience in IV sedation working in the Oral Surgery Department at Kings College Hospital London. He gained the Diploma in Dental Sedation in 2010. He is a member of EFAAD, SAAD and DSTG, and is setting up a sedation association and sedation training programs in Spain.

Nigel Robb

Nigel is SAAD's president and a Senior Lecturer/Consultant in Restorative Dentistry heading up the Sedation Unit at Glasgow Dental School. He has a vast experience in conscious sedation having co-authored one of the standard text books on the subject. Nigel is an authority and renowned international speaker on the subject of conscious sedation.

Sanjay Chopra

Sanjay, a Specialist Oral Surgeon, has been extensively involved with treating anxious dental patients since the early 1990's. In 1995 he co-founded the Highland View Dental Surgery in Essex, a specialist

referral practice accepting referrals for conscious Sedation, oral surgery and dental implants. He was a member "Intercollegiate Advisory Committee for Sedation in Dentistry" developing new recommendations in CPD for sedation practitioners.

Christopher Holden

Chris is a private GDP in Derbyshire, www.dental-clinic.co.uk. He has been an author of many national guidance documents on dental sedation in the last 20 years. Chris regularly provides expert evidence in courts and tribunals in the UK and abroad. He is an IACSD and DSTG committee member and also past president of SAAD and The International Federation of Dental Anesthesiology Societies.

Avijit Banerjee

Avijit is Reader in Cariology and Operative Dentistry/Honorary Consultant in Restorative Dentistry at KCL Dental Institute at Guy's Hospital, London. He has gained an international reputation as a UG/PG teacher, research supervisor, lecturer and published researcher in the fields of cariology and minimally invasive operative dentistry, minimum intervention dentistry and adhesive dental biomaterials. He is the primary author of Pickard's Manual of Operative Dentistry - 9th Ed (OUP, 2011) and is an editorial board member for Dental Update. His clinical interest in hospital lies in the oral/dental rehabilitation of people with oral cancer whilst maintaining part-time specialist practice in restorative dentistry.

Carole Boyle

Carole is a Consultant in Special Care Dentistry at KCL Dental Institute at Guy's Hospital. Her particular interests are using sedation for people who require special care, and teaching sedation both to undergraduates and postgraduates. She is president elect of SAAD.

Darrin Robinson

Since 2004 he has led IDH in three areas; clinical, NHS contracting and the management of the company's external relations with government and regulators. Tim Newton

Tim is Professor of Psychology as Applied to Dentistry at King's College London Dental Institute and leads the education and environment research theme. He has worked in the behavioural sciences in relation to dentistry for the last 19 years. In 2008 with his colleagues Koula Asimakopoulou and Suzanne Scott, he founded the United Kingdom's first Health Psychology Service for people who are dentally anxious within the Department of Sedation and Special Care Dentistry at KCL Dental Institute at Guy's Hospital.
